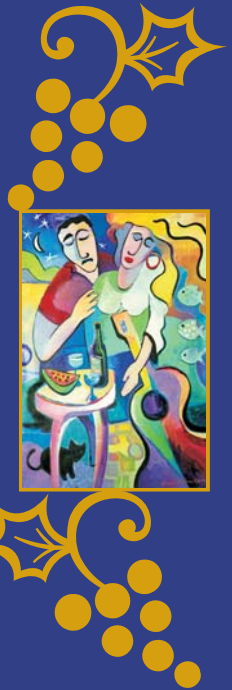

Lakeside Wine Company Presents Interlude: 2004 Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, & Barbera

The Capp's family has been farming in Napa County since the mid 1850's after coming to California in covered wagons before the Gold Rush. They raised orchard crops back then.

Around the turn of the last century, one of Dan's grandfathers came to America from Italy, where they'd been growing wine grapes back into the mists of time. Eventually, he made his way across America from Ellis Island to Oakland, then to eastern Napa County where he bought a farm with money he'd made mining gold in the Sierra Nevada mountains. That farm was planted to grapes then, but removed due to prohibition. He planted fruit trees, but made wine in the basement throughout his life.

We've been raising wine grapes since 1973 in our own vineyard in the eastern valleys of Napa County. The weather here is very much like St. Helena's in northern Napa County. We get cool, windy, wet springs followed by hot summer days with nights cooled by fog.

We've been selling our grapes to some of California's best wineries all these years. Now we think it's time that we sold our grapes directly to the consumer. We've tried to make this wine just like we like it-soft and mellow, with lots of fruit flavors like plums, cherries and blackberries, & hints of chocolate and vanilla on the finish that make ending the day with a glass a pleasure to share with family and friends.
